! WARNING: SAFETY RIDING RULES

The user must follow all safety rules and guidelines, or serious injury or death may occur to the user.

- Always use common sense and safe practices when using the vehicle. The user must be at least 2 years old and weigh no more than 20.5 kgs.
- This product contains small parts that are for adult assembly only. Keep small children away when assembling. Remove and dispose of all protective material and plastic bags before assembly.
- Riders must always wear a fitted helmet that complies with U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) Standard 16 CFR 1203.
- Only sit on the seat in the vehicle.
- Do not allow more than one rider.
- Do not overload the vehicle. Do not remove the weight restriction decals.
- Do not pull the vehicle with another vehicle or similar device.
- Keep body parts such as hands, legs, hair and clothing away from moving parts. Moving parts can cause serious injury.
- Always wear shoes in the vehicle.
- Do not operate near streets or motor vehicles.
- Do not operate near drop-offs such as steps, steep inclines or hills. Operate on relatively level ground.
- Do not operate near water, swimming pools or other fluids.
- Do not operate in dangerous weather conditions such as rain or snow.
- Do not operate near loose dirt, mud, sand or fine gravel.
- Do not operate near flammable vapors (gasoline, paint thinner, acetone, etc.).
- Always use the vehicle in a safe, secure environment with adult supervision.
- Risk of fire. Do not bybass.
- Adult assembly only.
- To reduce the risk of injury, adult supervision is required.
- Never use in road ways, near motor vehicle, on or near steep, inclines or steps, swimming pools or other bodies of water.

MARNING: BATTERY SAFETY

 Battery posts, terminals and related accessories contain lead and lead compound (asic) chemicals known to the state of California to cause cancer, reproductive harm, and are toxic and corrosive. DO NOT open the battery.



Contact exposure to battery leakage (lead acid) may cause serious injury.
 Immediately contact your doctor if exposure occurs. If the chemical is on the skin, flush immediately with cool water for 15 minutes. If the chemical is swallowed immediately give the person water or milk. Do not give water or milk if the person is vomiting or has decreased alertness. Do not induce vomiting.




 Tampering with or modifying the electric circuit system may cause shock, fi e or explosion. It could permanently damage the system. Keep the charger housing closed to prevent exposed wiring, which may cause electric shock.

IMPORTANT: Before using the vehicle for the first time, the battery must be charged for a full 18 hours (no more than 20 hours).




WARNING: ADULT SUPERVISION REQUIRED




To Charge the Battery:


- 1. Ensure the train is stopped and turned off.
- 2. Using a flat head sc ewdriver, turn the screw on the seat lid to the unlock position and lift lid.
- 3. Unplug the red battery connector (A) from the red engine connector (B).
- 4. Connect the red battery connector (A) to the red battery charger connector (C) and plug (D) into a 120 V outlet.
- 5. Once done charging, unplug the charger connector (C) from the red battery connector (A).
- 6. Reconnect the red battery connector (A) to the red engine connector (B).


To Remove the Battery:


- 7. Using a hex screwdriver, unscrew the hex screw on the battery strap.
- 8. Slide the battery strap (E) out. Disconnect the red battery connector (A) from the red engine connector (B).
- 9. Remove the battery (F) from the compartment.

Note: It is not necessary to remove the battery for charging. However, if the battery does not reach the outlet, it can be removed for charging.











10 Assemble the Oval track

The train track can be assembled in either an oval or a circle. To assemble the track in the oval shape follow the below steps.




- 1. Always assemble the track on a flat, smooth surfac
- 2. Connect 5 pieces of straight track together by snapping one straight piece on top of another piece until firmly connecte
- 3. Connect 6 pieces of curved track together to form a half circle
- 4. Connect the 5 pieces of straight track to 6 pieces of curved track
- 5. Connect the track set to the remaining 5 pieces of straight track
- 6. Connect the remaining 6 pieces of curved track to complete the oval



- 1. Always assemble the track on a flat, smooth surfac
- 2. Connect all 12 pieces of the curved track together to form a complete circle by snapping one curved piece on top of another until firmly connecte



12 Step & Caboose Assembly




Step Assembly:

1. Assemble the steps on the left and right side of the train




Caboose Assembly

1. Connect the hook on the caboose to the handle on the back of the steam train



- 1. Pour purified water into the steam tank on the top of the steam train
- 2. The maximum capacity of the tank is 60 ml (2 oz) of purified wate, which works for hours. The water will overflow if the water exceeds the tank capacity. The train will automatically power off steam if water becomes used up. If the train is turned on the side, the water may overflo .
- 3. Turn the train on by pushing the power switch on the steering wheel to the forward position. After a minute press any button on the steering wheel, and the steam will come out along with a fun train sound!
- 4. Each button produces steam as well as a different sound.

Three unique and fun train sounds! Buttons also activate steam function when water is poured into the steam tank. (See page 13).

Troubleshooting Information

• If the switch dos not work this may be due to poor connections or the fuse needs replacing. Please check the wire connections. If this does not solve the problem, then please check and replace the fuse. If the motor slows down or stops this may be due to a low battery. Please recharge the battery for approximately 10 hours. If the battery is not charging, this may be due to a damaged charger, a problem with the fuse plug, or the battery has come to the end of its battery life. Please check and replace the fuse or replace the battery.

Important Battery and Charger Information

- Only an adult who has read and understands the safety warnings may handle and operate the battery and battery charger. Keep away from children.
- Charge the battery for 18 hours before using the vehicle for the first time
- Charge the battery immediately after each use. Charge for at least 8-12 hours, but no more than 20 hours.
- Charge the battery at least once a month, even if the vehicle is not used or stored.
- Never leave the battery in a discharged condition.
- Connect the terminal of the battery and charger, then plug the charger into a 120V AC outlet.
- It is normal for the charger to heat slightly. If the charger rises above 71°C / 160°F, disconnect the charger and call Customer Service for assistance.
- Keep the charger away from water or excessive moisture to prevent shortcircuiting.
- Only use the charger specified with the original item. Do not charge the battery with any other charger.
- Do not attempt to recharge non-rechargeable batteries with the original charger.
- Do not replace the battery with any other battery, or the warranty will be voided.
- Remove damaged batteries from the car immediately. Recycle or dispose of the used batteries responsibly.
- Do not short circuit the supply terminals.
- Do not leave the battery connected in the vehicle for extended periods of time when the vehicle is not being used. Disconnect the battery connector from the engine connector before storing.
- The vehicle is equipped with a thermal fuse to protect the electric circuit. If the vehicle cuts out, turn the vehicle off and on to reset.

16 General Care & FCC Information

General Care

- Regularly inspect all vehicle parts to ensure they are in good working condition.
- Regularly inspect the charger, cord, plug, and other related parts for damage.
- Remove any damaged parts and immediately contact Customer Service for replacement parts.
- DO NOT operate the vehicle if there are any damaged parts.
- Carefully clean the vehicle with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not get water in or near any electrical parts. Do not wash the vehicle with a hose.
- Store the vehicle indoors or use a tarp to cover it. Keep away from stoves, heaters, or other sources of heat.

FCC Information

This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) this device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.

- This one-year limited warranty covers the ride-on vehicle against defects in materials and workmanship to the original purchaser. Proof of purchase receipt from an Aria Child certified eseller is required.
- Aria Child ensures the original 6-Volt battery is warranted for 6 months from initial purchase of the vehicle from a certified etailer. Proof of purchase receipt required.
- This warranty covers normal use and does not cover the Aria Child vehicle or battery if deemed damaged by unreasonable use, modification, neglect, accident abuse, misuse, improper service or other causes not arising out of defects in materials or workmanship. Evidence of any attempt at consumer repair will void this warranty.
- This warranty does not cover, and is not intended to exclude any liability on the part of Aria Child, whether under this warranty or implied by law for any indirect or consequential damages for breach of warranty. Some states may not allow the exclusion or limitation so this limitation may not apply to you.
